



USING THE OCSRI PHYSICIAN PORTAL

From your computer, you may access OCSRI's Physician Portal via secure communication using any current web browser.


Your password has been assigned based on the information you provided in requesting access and completing the Confidentiality Agreement. You have received a Welcome email with your password information included. If you have difficulty accessing your account due to incorrect password or username, please contact our Help Desk at 866-804-1736.

Please remember, signed agreements and federal law prevent users from releasing their login and password to any other person, including any employee or person acting on their behalf and further agree not to allow anyone else to access patient's information with their login and password.

When you have completed your work, it is important to always use the Logout link to exit the application and protect your secure access.

If, at any time, you feel your password may be compromised, contact our Help Desk at 866-804-1736, as soon as possible to change your password.

Enter your username, password and organization PIN that you received in the Welcome email.



Upon successful login, you will see your Patient List. For physicians with many patients being seen at OCSRI, enter the first few characters of your patient's last name to filter the list shorter.



Select the patient you would like to review by clicking on their name. On selecting a patient, you will be taken to the Demographics page for that patient. The patient name will be displayed along the top and center of the page.



Navigation tabs along the left side of the page allow you to browse to the section of the patient chart that is important to you. You may navigate back to your Patient List to select a different patient.
